Bay Hills Community Association President's Message

There has been a lot of activity regarding issues that affect our community and surrounding areas. There was a meeting on January 31st regarding the **hate mail** distributed in Anne Arundel County. The meeting was hosted by the Anne Arundel Race Relations Coordinating Committee. The panel at the meeting was comprised of State's Attorney Frank R. Weathersbee, Sheriff George F. Johnson, Human Relations Officer for AA Co. Human Relations Committee Adrian Wiseman, Deputy Chief Emerson Davis of the Anne Arundel County Police, Sergeant Timothy Hall of the Annapolis Police, and Tom Marquardt, Executive Editor of the Capital-Gazette. In the last year, thirty five communities in the county have been subjected to the dissemination of racist printed material. On the Broadneck peninsula, five communities have received papers and fliers. One solution discussed at the meeting was to establish Rapid Response Teams to hold "Town Hall" meetings and clean up property defamation. For Bay Hills, my opinion is to just discard the offensive papers, and if there is property defamation, to organize our own clean up, whether on

individual or community property.

On February 9th, the Anne Arundel County Department of Public Works (DPW) hosted a presentation of the **Mill Creek pumping station** situation. As you may have read

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in *the Capital*, the recent emergency situation has been resolved. The longer range situation requires replacement of the faulty concrete sewer pipes. The fundamental problem is that hydrochloric acid formed by sewage actually corrodes concrete, causing concrete wastewater pipelines to eventually fail. Pipeline replacements are performed by inserting a liner into the existing pipeline, and expanding the liner such that it becomes the new main and will not collapse even if the concrete fails. The DPW is currently doing this above the fault at Mill Creek. The DPW is also cleaning the creek and surrounding damaged areas. This phase is about 60 percent complete. One benefit for Bay Hills was learning

about the sewage and water routes and the effect breaks or shut downs will have on us. In the case of the Mill Creek

Minutes of Board Meeting - February 7th, 2006

The February 7th meeting of the Bay Hills Community Association was called to order by President Pat Nolan. Other board members present included Jeff Burkhart, Paul Cain, Lois Findlay, Lisa Franceschini, and Judy Roblyer. Also present was Jennifer Waters, *Beacon* editor.

Dues assessment invoices for 2006 were mailed 1/05/06. They stated that a \$25.00 late fee would be applied after 2/10/06. As of 2/03/06, two thirds of the dues or \$31,483.00 00 has been received. This includes 66% of the single family homes, the two apartment complexes and a few 2005 dues and late fees.

Lois and Lisa will prepare and send out second notices.

Jeff will personally contact those residents who have not paid their 2005 dues.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Capital Improvements: No items to report.

Covenants: The board reviewed a spreadsheet prepared by covenant committee chairman Paul Cain showing the different residences with covenant violations. Paul will send letters to all residences with a known covenant violation.

Long Range Planning: A list of six recommendations were presented to the board for areas in which work should be done within the next five years. They included a storage shed to house tennis equipment and community property to replace the storage unit we are presently renting, community landscaping, repair and annual maintenance of the tennis courts and basketball courts, private police patrols and community leaf collection. The board asked the committee to study further all recommendations.

Pavilion: No report.

Property & Ground Maintenance: No report.

Recreation: The Long Range Planning Committee suggested

that the tennis courts be cleaned and new nets and an anchor be purchased.

Resale Packets: No items to report.

Social: An adult holiday social has been scheduled for Sunday, December 3rd. A bus will pick up participants at 9:30 am in Bay Hills and drive to Toby's Dinner Theatre in Columbia, where we will enjoy brunch and a play "Miracle on 34th Street." Tickets will be \$35.50 per person and the association will pay for the bus.

Welcome: Two welcome bags were delivered to new residents.

OLD BUSINESS

The landscaping contract for the community properties has been finalized with G.P. Landscaping for two years with an option to extend for one additional year.

Pat will attend a meeting February 9th where the Anne Arundel County Public Works will present information about response and repair efforts, environmental assessments and remedial plans. This is a result of the recent sewage spill at Mill Creek.

break, the media reported that Arnold residents should limit water usage and not use toilets. The actual area affected included only a small portion of Arnold (not Bay Hills), but included most of Severna Park. In Bay Hills, we will post emergency information on the web site for such events. (The web site is listed every month in *The Beacon*.) In the case of a power outage, we will notify our residents individually, but understand that the logistics of this system are still being worked out. The good news is that I requested and received a prompt reply about the situation when power outages occur. Both sewage pumping stations and the water treatment plant have or are currently being equipped with backup generators for use during power outages. This effort will be completed this year.

Another inquiry concerned the **Corduroy Road** also known as College Parkway. The College Parkway pipeline work from Anne Arundel Community College to Rosslare was addressed by Steve Burzenski of the DPW. He said, "We anticipate that the installation of the water transmission main will be complete by the end of February. Pipe testing will occur in March, and final pavement restoration will be completed in April."

If anyone has any information about the **dumping of bags of leaves and trash at the pool area**, I would appreciate being notified. Either the pool or the community has to

pay to have this hauled away. We will bill the "dumpees" for this service. These dumping occurrences are especially aggravating since the county has pick-ups twice a week, so there should be no need for such illegal dumping.

Speaking of dumping, we will have the **community dumpsters** again this spring. They will be delivered by noon on March 30th and picked up by 8:00 am on April 1st. Look for information on prohibited items on p. 9 in this issue of *The Beacon*. The dates for drop-off of these prohibited items are March 18th, June 10th, and October 21st at Millersville Landfill and May 20th, September 9th, and November 18th at Glen Burnie Convenience Center. Because of numerous abuses of this program in the past, the dumpsters will be monitored. Please follow the direction of the monitors.

Bay Hills will have its **community yard sale** on Saturday, April 22nd. In addition to signs, there will be an advertisement placed in the *Pennysaver*. If you are new to the community, the process is to set up the items you would like to offer for sale in your driveway, in front of your residence, or in your garage. The community yard sale hours are typically from 8:00 am to 1:00 or 2:00 pm.

For long term planning, **save the date** of December 3rd for the Bay Hills Holiday Social. More information to come.

The Medicare Part D Assistance Center allows County Seniors to come in, free of charge, and work with professionals from the Department of Aging and Disabilities to get the best prescription coverage for their needs. "Our goal is to provide the assistance needed by Medicare beneficiaries so that they can make informed and timely decisions that will prevent them from finding themselves in a crisis situation after May 15th," said Department of Aging and Disabilities Director Virginia Thomas.

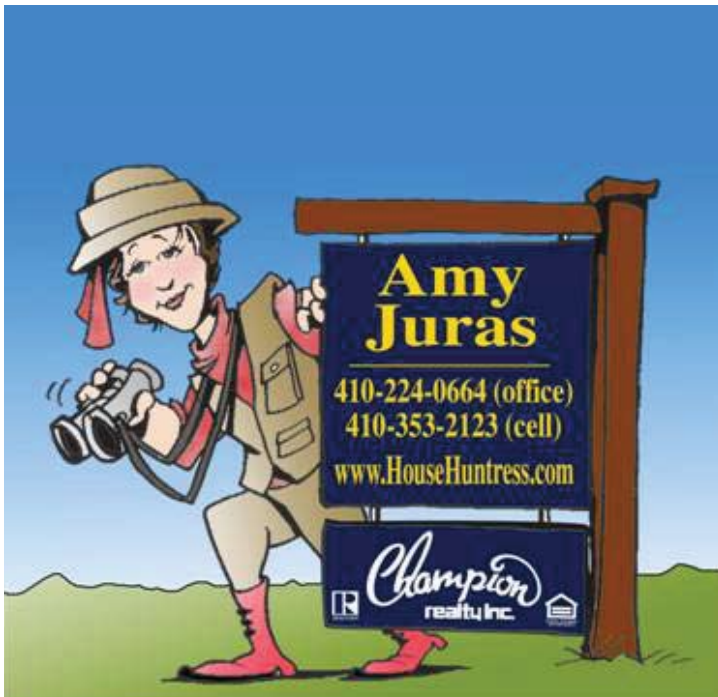
