The Bay Hills Traffic Committee met with the Assistant Chief of the Traffic Engineering Division, Department of Public Works for Anne Arundel County, Ed Horky and Corporal Wayne Tannis of the Anne Arundel County Police to determine the issues that need to be resolved regarding traffic issue in our community. Of course, the primary concerns are speeding and the cut-through traffic from outside the community. Other issues discussed were lack of observance of traffic signs, drivers not stopping for school busses, and general disregard for pedestrians. The committee asked for the county to act as quickly as possible before anyone else is hurt or killed. We expect to hear from them shortly. Speed monitoring is being done by the county as well as the police. Relocation and addition of speed humps is being examined also.

Minutes of Board Meeting - November 7th, 2006

The November Board meeting was held on November 7th, 2006 at the Providence Center. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by President Pat Nolan.

The Board voted unanimously to elect Joyce Smithey as a Board member.

Corrections were provided to Bay West Management on the draft contract for dues administration and other account management services for 2007. We expect to have a signed contract in place by November 30th, 2006.

Bob West of Fiducial confirmed with the state of Maryland that we should be receiving a \$700 refund on overpayment of estimated taxes soon. Anne Arundel County applied a refund of overpayment on Personal Property Tax to our FY07 bill.

Treasurer completed and submitted an application to the county's Community Grant Program for up to \$1,000 of matching funds towards the cost of replacing the fabric on the front basketball court. The program no longer requires public access as a condition of receiving county funding. We will hear the status by December 15th, 2006.

A comparison of YTD revenues (\$59,062) and expenses (\$50,870) with the 2006 budget was provided. The expenses include a \$5,000 transfer from the operating budget to the capital reserve fund.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Communications: The Board discussed that the luminary

project is approaching and noted the contact people for the project.

Covenants: The blacktop truck that was parked on golf Course Drive is no longer parked there.

The Board will look into a white truck that is parked on Pine Valley 3 days per week.

The Board also discussed a resident who is storing a large amount of fuel in his garage in a 55-gallon drum. The fire department has reported that it does not deal with fuel storage issues.

Long Range Planning: The Board is obtaining quotes from landscape architects for a comprehensive community landscaping plan.

Property & Ground Maintenance: Some work on the grounds around the tennis courts is completed. An 8-foot collar of mulch was placed around the courts along with weed killer, and a pair of trees was removed. The Board is getting bids to plant in this area in the spring.

Weeds were cleared around the volleyball area.

The retaining wall near the pavilion is starting to buckle due to erosion. The Board plans to stabilize it without removing it.

The Board is also acquiring bids to bulldoze a path to the Shore Acres and Golf Course lot. It is looking into a right of way to this community property. The Board also discussed getting a waiver of liability from sports groups using the lot.

Trash is being taken to the curb at the basketball courts one time each week, and new liners are being placed in the basket.

Social: The Halloween Party was held Saturday, October 28th and photos from the event appeared in the November 2nd issue of the Capital.

Welcome: Three welcome bags were delivered. The Welcome Party will be Sunday, October 1st, 2-4 at the pavilion. Old and new residents are encouraged to come.

OLD BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS

Lois Findlay applied for a grant from the Anne Arundel County Department of Parks and Recreation to defray costs for replacing the basketball fence. The grant allows the facility to be used only by the community and will not result in opening the court to all county residents. The current fence is rotting, but the foundation is sound. The Board is in the process of getting bids for the work. The plans are to keep the fence the same size at it is currently. The fence repairs are planned for sometime prior to March.

The traffic committee had a traffic meeting with members of the County Public Works Department. The community's traffic

collecting your annual Bay Hills assessment. If you inadvertently send one payment to the other, it's a mess to sort out. Do yourself a favor: avoid confusion and avoid late fees by remitting your payments carefully and correctly!

Residents of St. Andrew Hill: Bay West manages your condo association and will also be collecting your annual Bay Hills dues. Please write separate checks so they can account for your payments properly.

Residents of Bay Hills Apartments and Oakland Hills Apartments: Your annual dues are paid for in a lump sum by your apartment management company (\$30/apt). You will not receive an invoice from Bay West.

Single Family Homeowners: You will receive an invoice from Bay West (instead of ProCom) for the annual community association assessment.

New Immunization Requirements for Schoolchildren

The Maryland school immunization requirements for children enrolled in preschool and kindergarten through ninth grade have changed. The following **additional** vaccinations are required **by January 2, 2007**:

- Students enrolled in preschool programs and kindergarten through 9th grade are required to be immunized against **hepatitis B** (series of three shots administered over six months). Students who have started the series but have not had all three shots will be permitted to enter school.
- Students enrolled in preschool programs and kindergarten through 9th grade are required to show proof of vaccination against **varicella (chickenpox)**. Having a medical diagnosis of chickenpox can be accepted in lieu of vaccination.
- **Pneumococcal (PCV7)** vaccination is now required for children enrolled in preschool programs.

For a complete list of required immunizations, contact your child's health care provider, the Department of Health's Immunizations Services Program (410-222-4896) or go to <http://edcp.org/pdf/at105092.pdf>.

Throughout the year, the Anne Arundel County Department of Health provides immunizations to County children from birth to 18 years of age. Immunizations are free, but donations up to \$10.00 are appreciated. Call one of the local health centers for an appointment or a schedule of walk-in clinics:

concerns were discussed, including speeding, failure to stop at stop signs, and cut through traffic. The speed bump past the stop sign at Bay Dale and Bay Green will come back. Suggested solutions were discussed, including the use of a constriction island. Traffic surveys will be conducted in the neighborhood to assess traffic control options. The Board also discussed inviting the President of the Ulmstead Estates' Board of Directors to attend the next meeting to discuss the issue of cut-through traffic.

The Board discussed sending out a list of committees and vacancies to solicit volunteers for committee assignments. The Board also considered adding a financial committee.

County News and Broadneck Federation: Some county news was discussed, including the installation of new sewer lines along College Parkway. At the last meeting of the Broadneck Federation, an offer was made to have emergency preparedness people provide information talks to the community in a short program if there was interest. The next Broadneck Federation meeting will include a presentation by the Maryland Transportation Authority on the re-decking of the Chesapeake Bay Bridge.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:40pm. The next meeting will be December 5th at the Providence Center on Shore Acres Road.

The Final 2006 Flu Vaccination Clinic

Last month's *Beacon* listed the scheduled immunization clinics held by Anne Arundel County Department of Health to provide flu vaccine to County residents. The last of the scheduled clinics is to be held December 11th at the Health Services Building, 3 Harry S. Truman Parkway, Annapolis, from 1:00–4:00 pm and 5:00–7:00 pm.

The national Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommend vaccinations for anyone who wants to prevent the flu, as well as certain priority groups. Priority groups are: persons 50 years of age and older; individuals with chronic medical conditions such as heart disease, diabetes, kidney disease, cancer and HIV/AIDS; children 6-59 months old; pregnant women; healthcare personnel who provide direct patient care; and household contacts and out-of-home caregivers of children less than 5 years old.

Pneumococcal vaccine will be also available at all clinic locations. Pneumococcal vaccine is recommended for persons over 65 years old, for persons with chronic heart and pulmonary conditions, and particularly for persons who have lost their spleen or have sickle cell anemia. For most people, pneumococcal vaccine only needs to be given once in a lifetime.

Although immunizations are free, the Department appreciates donations to help pay the cost of administering the vaccines. The suggested donation is \$20. Medicare Part B will cover the \$20 donation for both flu and pneumococcal vaccines; however, individuals must bring their Medicare cards.

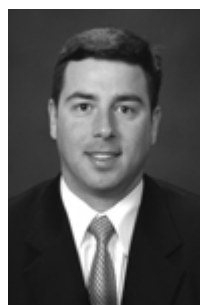
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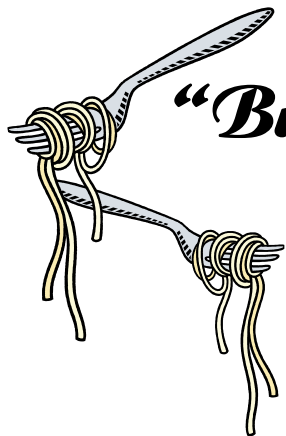
